Our organisation has implemented an Information Security System based on ISO-IEC 27.001 standards, offering engineering, consultancy and project management services in the areas of Telecommunications, Energy and R+D+i.

To achieve these objectives, the Diggia Group has established the following principles:

- Establish annual objectives in relation to Information Security.
- Comply with business, legal or regulatory requirements and contractual obligations.
- Carry out training and awareness-raising activities on Information Security processes for all personnel.
- Establish the necessary means to guarantee the continuity of Grupo Diggia's business.
- Develop a risk analysis process for information assets.
- Establish the control objectives and the corresponding controls to mitigate the risks detected.
- Establish the responsibility of employees in relation to:

-Comply with the policies and procedures inherent to the Information Security Management System.

-Preserve the confidentiality, integrity and availability of information assets in compliance with this policy.
